Highlights of 2010

Greetings in the precious name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ! It was so nice to see many of you at the Denton Bible Church missions conference. We are very thankful to the Lord for the blessings that he has sent our way during this past year. We would like to share some of those highlights with you.

1) The starting of the BTCP in Nepal. The Lord has enabled us to start a BTCP class in Nepal. Dr. Joy David and I taught the classes. We had about 50 students for the program and most of them were pioneer evangelists to the obscure villages of Nepal. Some of them walked for days to get to the

program. Others were the older students at the Orphanage. They have about 30 students who are older than 18 years and it is their hope that these men and women may become evangelists to their villages.

2. BTCP in various places. By the grace of God, the existing BTCP classes in are going very well. We currently have 7 BTCP classes in various places in India. Mr. George Christy, Jose Mathew and I conducted the classes. We have seen the Spirit of God using the word of God to change the lives of people. So the study of the word of God was not merely an intellectual exercise.

3. Starting of the work in Vipin and the establishment of the church. Vipin is the most populated island in the world and the Lord enabled us to start a work there. We, with the help of believers from various churches that we fellowship with, have shared the gospel in that island from house to house. The Lord gave us opportunities to preach on various street corners. Many people have professed their faith in the Lord and a few have joined us to start a church in Vipin.

4. The progress of the bible training institute. The Lord helped us to continue our training of 25 young men at the Bible Training Institute. I had the privilege of teaching them the Old Testament Survey. I greatly enjoyed going through the Old Testament with them understanding the nature of our great God in His dealing with His people.

5. The beginning of the BTCP in Delhi. The word about the BTCP classes has spread around India and abroad and we were invited by our friends in Delhi to start a program there.

6. The beginning of the mission stations in MP. The Lord has encouraged the hearts of some of our brothers and 4 families have moved to the North Indian state of Madhya Pradesh for evangelism and church planting. It is a state with anti-conversion laws but the Lord is giving them success and protection. The Lord has enabled them to start 3 churches in that area.

7. The counseling training seminar with Dr. John Henderson. The counseling training camp with Dr. John Henderson was a special blessing to all of the participants. We had a time of self examination before the Lord and the Lord has helped us in many specific areas of our lives.

8. The missions trip ACA students with Neil Tomba of North West Bible Church. The visit of Pastor Neil Tomba with the students of ACA was helpful in making inroads to Cochin University. Please pray that we might be able to reach many from various parts of India that are at the University.

9. Beginning of BTCP in the middle east. This year the Lord has enabled us to start a BTCP program in the Middle East and Bro. Jose Mathew is moving there to continue the program.
